Missio Dei – a mission of love

Mission invites us, but does not depend on our human endeavour

Incarnation – self-giving and cruciform love

- God enters our lives in ultimate vulnerability and solidarity
- God opens the way to redemption and new life, life in abundance
- Mission invites us to share our lives complete and fully

Discipleship

- As the Father has sent me, so I send you (Jn 20:21)
- Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus (Phil 2:5)

But

- Self-giving love is not self-denial or self-negation, but rather a free choice and an act of love
- Are we sure that our choice is responding to God's call?

Suffering

- is a dark intrusion and an inexplainable violation
- is destructive
- Is an unavoidable part of the human condition
- can be transformative

Jesus links suffering to discipleship



When care and sacrifice seem to contradict each other in mission, what are the questions to consider?

Ubuntu and Sangsaeng as theological concepts

- interdependence
- responsibility towards a mutually life-giving choice and reality
